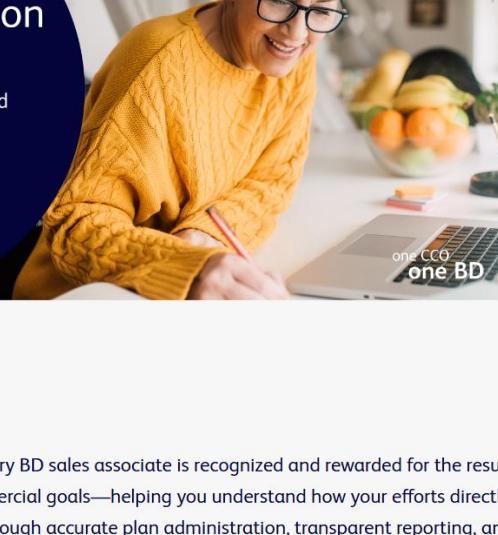

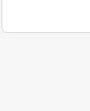

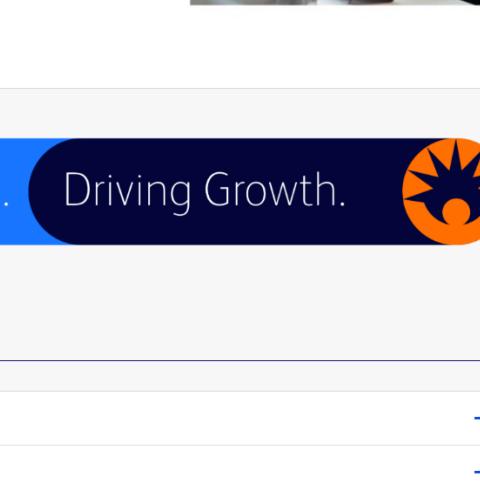
## About

**When an exemption from the outlined Incentive Compensation standards is required, the request must be substantiated and approved.**

### Requesting an Exception to U.S. Region Incentive Compensation Standards

To ensure consistency and alignment, this form is required for any exception request to the U.S. Region Incentive Compensation Standards. All requests must include supporting documentation and will be reviewed for strategic and policy alignment. Submitted materials will be shared with the U.S. Region President, BU VP/GM, and BU HR, Finance, and Legal leaders. A response will be provided within **2 business days**.

Step 1 - Incentive Compensation team is responsible for identifying exemption and sends Microsoft Form link to requestor.

Step 2 - Requesting party fills out justification form. Based on exemption scenario, approval will be required.

Step 3 - Incentive Compensation team sends form response to U.S. Region, VPGM, HR, Finance, and Legal.

Step 4 - If no feedback received within 2 business days alignment is assumed. Otherwise, IC will schedule a meeting with all parties for alignment. BU is responsible for communicating exception to their field sales team(s).
